



RECYCLING

RDEK YELLOW BIN PROGRAM

The yellow bins accept the following materials:

PAPER

All mixed paper (such as newspaper, magazines, phone books, brochures, books, envelopes)

CARDBOARD

All types of cardboard (excluding cardboard covered in wax such as milk cartons).

TIN AND ALUMINUM CANS

Food and beverage cans; rinse well.

PLASTICS

The following plastics are accepted:

Household plastics #1 - #6
Plastic grocery bags.

NOT ACCEPTED

Aluminum foil, styrofoam, #7 plastics, unmarked plastics, plastic film and glass. Glass recycling bins are available at the Fernie Transfer Station.

RDEK Yellow recycling bins are available to the public! Bins are located behind City Hall, the Aquatic Centre and the Arena.

City of Fernie Blue Bag Recycling Program: The City of Fernie offers residents curbside recycling pickup. Materials that can be recycled in the RDEK Yellow Bin program can also be recycled in the City Blue Bag Recycling program. Remember: All recycling must be in containers or blue/clear plastic bags to avoid weather conditions and ease of handling including your cardboard. See the Active Living Guide or call City Hall for pickup schedules.

The Fernie Municipal Transfer Station is located on Coal Creek Road. This site is open to the public Monday to Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The transfer station is closed on Statutory Holidays. There is no charge for regular household garbage or yard and garden waste (under 6" in diameter). There is no charge for recycled materials.
